

A Demonstration

by

Dennis Wake

At Walsgrave Baptist Church on Saturday 13th November 2021

We welcomed Dennis Wake to the Walsgrave Baptist Church for our meeting on the 13th November to demonstrate his skill of woodturning. Once again the attendance was well below normal levels but this gave us a good opportunity to meet fellow club members and catch up on the news. Besides the demonstration Dennis had brought along a good many samples of his work to show us and a table full of wood blanks etc for sale ably looked after by Dennis's wife.



One club member had brought along samples of his ornamental turnings to show us of which one had won him an award.



Dennis Wake started of by turning a lidded box and he stressed all the safety aspects of turning and especially concentrated on telling us the limitations of each tool suct as the Roughing gouge which really is properly named as the "Spindle Roughing Gouge". He asked the audience if anyone used it on bowl turning and one hand went up. Dennis then said that he should really cease using it for this purpose and produced a sample of a broken roughing gouge which had been mailed to him by a member of another club who had escaped serious injury when it broke and flew past his head.

As the lidded box was deemed to be spindle turning Dennis used this tool to rough out the wood and explained that he would be putting chucking

poins on both ends and the parting it through at an appropriate point along its length. This done he remounted the main part of the box and proceeded to hollow this portion out. I will not go into detail of how he turned the end to fit the lid but can say that you really need to attend these demonstrations to get those details for yourself.

Dennis then told us he would turn a candlestick to hold a glass container with a tea light in it. Here again it was spindle turning but with more details such as beads and coves so this took us further into the skills of tool control using a spindle gouge.

The final item that Dennis turned consisted of three pieces incorporating both, spindle turning and bowl turning and he showed us a sample he had turned earlier to give us an idea of the piece in question.





The piece sitting on the lathe bed Left is the finished article which was turned in front of us as a demonstration in turning and design and we were invited to do a critique as we should always do on our own work as this is the best way of improving our skills.
