#### **Off-Centre Snail**

By Paddy Byrne

This is Paddy's version of Laurent Cortot's (French woodturner) snail. Also inspired by Ian Ethel's off-centre turned honey dipper. The pictures May be a bit confusing as I have mixed my photos taken from in front of the lathe, with Paddy's photos taken from behind the lathe...




#### Snail's Shell


Sapele 4" square by 6" long. Already drilled with a 25mm hole for the snail's body. Dimensions below are for a smaller snail.




Dimensions for a smaller snail. Block size for shell. 100mm x 60mm.



Dimensions for a smaller snail. Hole for body drilled in shell block before turning. 20mm diameter hole, 25mm from end of blank and as close to the bottom of the blank as possible.





Shell turned to round and a chuck spigot added. Mounted in chuck and trued-up again.



Diameter reduced until drilled hole just breaks through the side of the block. Round over the end.



Round over the other end of the shell but leave it slightly longer than the other side and taper it down.




Cut a series of steps to mimic the spiral of a snail's shell. Only one side of the shell has a spiral.

Sand, seal and wax.

Part off.










Block for body. 150mm x 45mm.



First offset for body, to create the tail.

Mark top of block and drop the end till a 2-3mm gap appears in the chuck jaw at the top.



Length and diameter measurements for the tail. Mark 3 pencil lines at 35, 80 and 100 mm.



Turn the end down to 15mm and round over the end. Taper the block so that the diameter at the 35mm line is 25 to 30 mm.

Snail's body showing the straight middle section and the dropped tail.



Start to form the collar ring behind the head. This side of the collar is turned on centre (no offset).



Second offset for body block to shape the head. 4mm offset on opposite side to the first offset.



Length of eye stalk 20mm and a diameter of 3mm. Paddy has a metal template with a 3mm hole.



Eye stalk offset. Drop the end of the block by only 1mm. This gives a good size for the eye.

Turn the diameter of the rest of the block down until level with the stalk.



Round over the front of the eye and part off.



The finished eye and stalk. Now make another identical one!



Drill 3mm holes in the head. Assemble the snail by gluing the body into the shell and gluing the eye stalks into the head.


